

The Time Has Arrived!

F.D.A. Legislation-Registration-Compliance Deadlines

The Bioterrorism Preparedness Act of 2002 (Article III) has implemented its final ruling, which requires the maintenance of records by persons who manufacture, process, pack, distribute, receive, or import food in or to the U.S.

Records must allow for the identification of previous sources and subsequent recipients of food. Persons covered by the regulation who employ 500 or more full-time employees (FTEs) had to be in compliance by Dec. 9/2005, and those who employ 11 to 499 FTEs- June 9/2006; 10 or fewer FTEs- Dec. 11/2006.

Records must be made available to the FDA within 4 hrs. betw. 8:00am-6:00pm Mon.-Fri., or 8 hrs. any other time.

Registration: 21 CFR Parts 1 and 20

The FDA's final reg. requires domestic and foreign facilities that manufacture, pack, or hold food for human or animal consumption in the U.S. to register by Dec. 12/03.

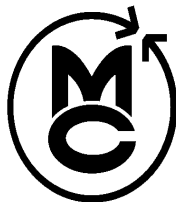

- 1) Dec. 11/2006--Final date for All to be Compliant.
- 2) FDA availability: 4 hrs. Mon. through Fri. (8am-6pm), 8 hrs.-other.
- 3) Regist. by-Dec. 12/2003- We urge companies to please register to enable the FDA to Act!
